Start by stacking everything on the card and make sure it all fits right from the border. If something doesn't fit, you may need to trim it, or make the boundaries smaller. When laying out wooden pieces like Christmas trees, put the items in front closer to the bottom to give a better sense of three sizes and depth. Now that you're sure it's all right, lets you start by sticking together in the background. Put a small amount of glue on the construction paper, smooth it and fasten it on the card. Then it's time to glue the boundaries. Start at the bottom of the border. Make it as flush with the bottom of the card as possible, so that it can properly stand up when the card is open. The next move is on the sides and on top. Trim the sides down to make them fit as needed. Now we need to prepare our trees. By now, I'm sure you've discovered how easily a balsa tree can divide. We should give a little extra insurance against this for parts that aren't adhesive directly to the map. If you still have a pattern with trees before, you can use it or make a paper copy of it. Trim just a little off all the edges, so it's a little smaller than your tree. Now stick this paper on the back of the tree with a thin, even amount of glue. Remember the scraps before I told you to save it? Cut off small pieces of them to mount on the back of the front tree.
